The national standardized child safety technician certification course is four days long and combines classroom instruction, hands-on work with car seats and vehicles, and a community safety seat check-up event.

Topics covered will include:

- Child Passenger Safety Technician Role
- Injury Prevention and Crash Dynamics
- Seat Belt Systems
- Air Bags
- Lower anchors and tethers for children
- Introduction to car seats and booster seats
- Children in rear facing seats
- Children in forward facing seats
- Children in booster seats and seat belts
- CPS in other vehicles
- Installation and communication
- Recertification and Check-up event

There will be 3 quizzes and 3 hands-on skills assessments during this course.

Successful completion of this course certifies the individual as a CPS technician for two (2) years.
